


Tech for Trans People

Data Destruction




- Throw data away

- How are you protecting users?






When I'm at HOME, my gender is NONBINARY

When I'm at HOME, my gender is NONBINARY and I use THEY/THEM pronouns


When I'm at WORK, my gender is FEMALE and I use SHE/HER pronouns

When I'm at WORK, my (safety) gender is FEMALE and I tolerate SHE/HER pronouns because my workplace is transphobic








Gender Statement v3...n
